



tPMCrafty: Software Version History

tPMCrafty is a corpus “handcrafting” tool that allows you to open text files, perform some transformations and then output the results as plain text with UTF-8 and/or UTF-16 file encoding. It is a separate application from *The Prime Machine*, but was designed with tPM’s DIY Text Tools in mind. The software was developed by Stephen Jeaco.
